



RV Breakdown Checklist

The day BEFORE you leave

Close the grey tank

TAKE YOUR TIME

Moving Day

Check fluids in truck before starting & tire pressure and wear

Check & Clean roof and Slide top

Empty/flush black tank

Empty grey tank

Add chemicals to tanks with 2 gallons of water (ish)

Disconnect & Stow black tank flush hose

Disconnect & Stow sewer hose & slinky

Turn off breaker at pedestal & unplug surge protector. Wrap up cord & stow

Disconnect and stow freshwater hose & filter

Retract Stabilizers

Turn off propane & Batteries

Connect tow vehicle

Remove chocks

Check tire pressure & wear on trailer

WALK AROUND THE RIG, check function of lights, double check the hitch, check all compartments

In the tow vehicle

Check tire PSI on TPMS

Check trailer brake

TAKE YOUR TIME

INSIDE

Secure all cabinets and place tension rods in fridge

Secure TV

Close Stovetop

Stow all items on countertop and table

Drop the table height

Make sure kitchen counter leaf is lowered

Secure shower door, make it click

Turn off fridge

Add chemicals to tanks, once verified they have been flushed

Secure lock on bathroom door

Make sure bed is in the upright position and locked

Verify the slide is clear and close once verified with outside person

Check control panel, Is everything off?

Walk around the site one last time to make sure everything has been packed and stowed correctly, Chairs, bbq, rugs etc.
